### **Stage 2**

Applications (Stage 1) are submitted highlighting ability to meet criteria and an assessment panel/process is made up of a 6 member panel:

- SWAS CEO
- 2 x SWAS Board members
- 3 x Independent (WAIS, DSR ,WA Sports Federation)

The assessment panel processes all submission and shortlist sports who are then invited to enter into Stage 2.

Stage 2 involves a presentation by the applicant in conjunction with their relevant State Sporting Association on the basis of their sports ability and commitment to be part of the South West Academy of Sport.

This approach will provide appropriate feedback to those sports that are not accepted into the Academy and evidence based justification of those who are. Such a process should enhance SWAS creditability.
