

Stepping out for WA

AUSTRALIND young gun Callum Richardson has been selected for the WA under-15 soccer squad to compete at the National Championships in Coffs Harbour, NSW at the end of this month.

It is the second time the promising South West Academy of Sport athlete will represent WA after playing in the under-14 State team last year.

He is the only member from the South West and will be pitted against NSW Metro, South Australia, Victoria Metro, Northern NSW and Capital Football in group A.

WA will field under-14 and under-15 teams for the tournament which will run from September 28 to October 1.

Warren Grieve will coach the under-14 boys with assistant Darren Young and the under-15s will be coached by Kenny Weston assisted by Chris Ola.

"The players have worked really hard and are relishing the opportunity to play against some of the best players in the country," Grieve said.

"This year's Nationals will be a real test with both the 14's and 15's in Group A."
