

McTaggart selected for Junior World Titles

MARGARET River's Creed McTaggart has become the top under 16 surfer in Australia and will soon be on his way to Ecuador to compete in the Junior World Titles.

McTaggart was selected for the national team after winning an event in Kingscliff, New South Wales earlier this month. The 15-year-old is set to travel to Ecuador in March.

McTaggart's success scored him a scholarship from the South West Academy of Sport.

"The scholarship will get me to more competitions by covering some of my travel costs," the surfer said.

McTaggart has been surfing since he was five.

"It's just so much fun," he said. "In Margaret River there are always waves, so you always have the opportunity to go surfing."
