

Soccer star picked again in State team

HARVEY teenager Domonique Fedele cemented her status as one of the region's more promising young soccer stars recently when she was named in the State under-17s team.

It is the second consecutive year the talented 15-year-old has represented Western Australia, having previously impressed in the State under-15s team.

The annual event features the best young players from around the country and serves as a talent identification tournament where national coaches from all levels discover future young Matildas.

pionships, following her inclusion in last year's tournament.

"It's quite overwhelming at first but after the first game you know what to expect," she said.

Fedele said the academy soccer program had helped her get ready for high level competitions such as the upcoming nationals.

"The specialised coaching has really helped me out in terms of skills development," she said.
